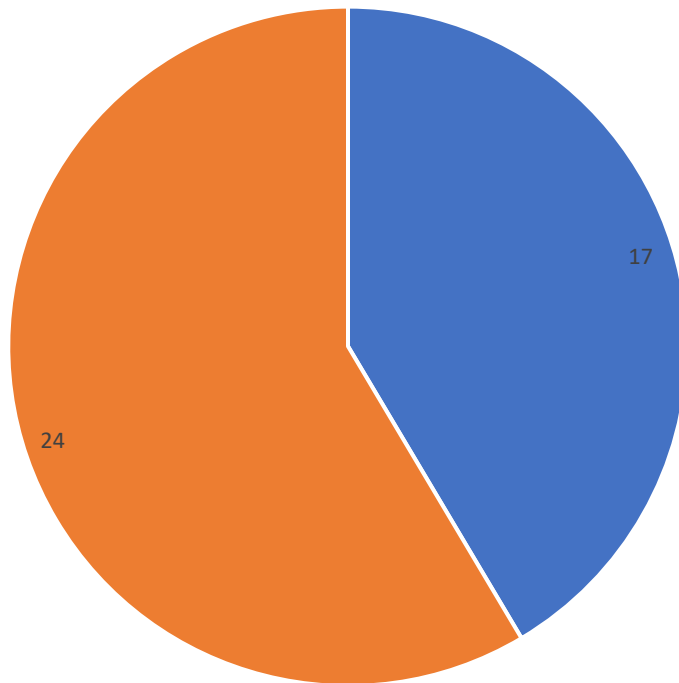


## Staff Post-Training Survey
